Your child's four-year-old kindergarten year is here, and we would like to warmly welcome you to the Lake Geneva Schools!

At registration, parents ask us, "What skills will the four-year-old kindergarten teachers expect my child to have?" To help answer those questions (and ease your mind), we've asked our highly regarded four-year-old kindergarten teachers to share their insights on helping your child gain the right mix of kindergarten-readiness skills.



Encouraging self-help skills is an important step to preparing your child for four-year-old kindergarten. Individual skills develop at different times and rates for each child. These readiness skills are intended to guide your work and play with your child in preparation for a successful transition to 4K.

Teachers expect children to:

- Get coats on and off and hang them up
- Follow simple two-step instructions such as "take off your boots and put on your sneakers"
- Go to the bathroom and wash their hands
- Blow their nose and cover their mouth when they cough
- Fasten and unfasten simple buttons and snaps
- Eat neatly and pour into a cup
- Open up a juice box and get the straw in.
- Play cooperatively with a small group of peers
- Share ideas willingly and speaks in complete sentences
- Communicate needs appropriately
- Wait one's turn
- Establish respectful relationships with adults
- Begin to feel comfortable being separated from parents
- Follow routines
- Understands rules of safety
